The curriculum which the Archdiocese uses is from the Circle of Grace program. "The goal of the Circle of Grace program is to educate and empower children and young people to actively participate in a safe environment for themselves and others."*

The Holy Spirit's Religious Education program also teaches the Circle of Grace program. It is taught towards the beginning of the school year.
